Program title:	Social Integration Summer Camp 2010
Description	Our summer camp allows all children to have equal opportunity to experience fun and engaging learning activities, as well as, enhance their communication and social skills through interactive group activities.

Program Length	July 12 th – July 30, 2010 and August 9 - August 27 th (six weeks)
Program Cost	5 half days a week - \$250, 3 half days a week - \$150, 2 half days a week - \$100
Admission Criteria	All exceptional children are welcome! We ask that you provide the staff with any documentation that will help the staff integrate your child's needs into the daily programming. Examples include; psychological assessments, speech language assessments and or reports as well as occupational therapist assessments and or reports. We ask that children are capable of some communication and can attend in a group with 1 instructor to 3 children ratio. T.I.P.E.S does have the option of one-to one for the camp, however spaces are limited. Siblings of children attending the camp are also eligible to attend if space is available. Activities	All the activities are designed specifically to meet every child's needs. Activities that will be provided are dependent on the group age and skill level. Activities include, circle time/group time, games, vocational skills, science experiments, outdoor activities, gross and fine motor activities and more!!! Focus is placed on assisting the children with communicating in a social setting using an ABA based approach.
Restrictions, etc.	Children must be 4 years of age.
Disability/Special Needs	Children with PDD (eg. Autism) and additional or related exceptionalities. Siblings are eligible to attend if space is available.
